Siccome per noi la sicurezza viene prima di tutto, vi segnaliamo che camere terapeutiche di decompressione per il trattamento con ossigeno iperbarico all'avanguardia si trovano in tutta Cipro, nelle immediate vicinanze di tutti i siti di immersione. Il tempo di massimo stimato per la struttura più vicina è di 30 minuti.
